PURPOSE

The Bigfork Water and Sewer District is inviting the community to a public meeting to provide an update on the progress of the Bay Sewer Replacement Project. The District's Engineer will provide an overview of the project, impacts during construction, anticipated schedule, and answer any questions.

ANTICIPATED IMPACTS SERVICE LINE PUMPS

Sewer services West of Electric Avenue and Bridge Street will be converted to a pressure sewer system. This will require the installation of a grinder pump on these service lines. These pumps will be paid for and installed by the District, but will be the responsibility of the property owner to maintain after the project is completed. The pumps will be connected to the building's sewer and electrical service as part of this project. Following construction, remote monitoring and/or service contracts will be available from private service providers.

ROAD CLOSURES & ACCESS RESTRICTIONS

This project will require temporary road closures and/or access restrictions to install new infrastructure. The District plans to mitigate this disruption by completing the improvements in two phases (spring and fall), pausing during the busy summer months when tourism is at it's peak.

LANDSCAPING

Disruption to landscaping should be anticipated to install the new grinder pumps, service lines, and electrical lines. Please let us know if you have any landscaping features that might be affected by construction by contacting Jeff Cicon at the phone or email listed below.
